## A Brief Introduction

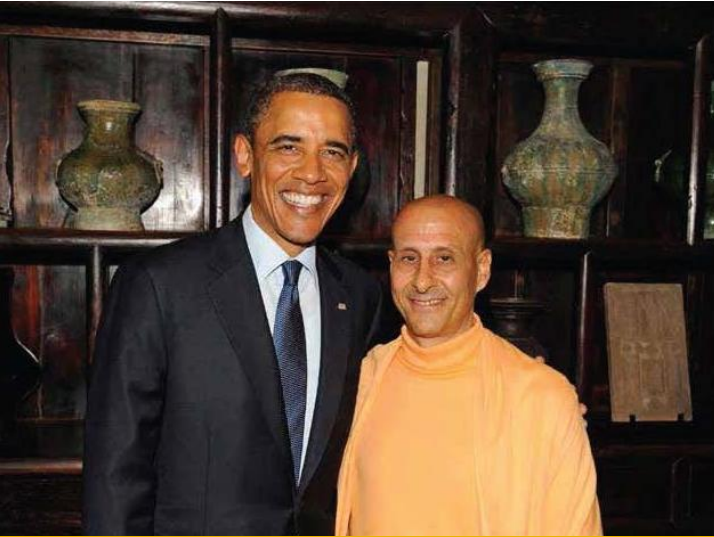
